

Seattle's Transit Network

Frequent All Day Service
Every 15 minutes or better, until 7 pm, Monday to Friday. Every 30 minutes or better until midnight every day. Most routes/lines are frequent late nights and weekends.

- Link light rail rapid transit
- Lines
- RapidRide limited stop bus for a faster ride
- Frequent bus route
- Basic routes combining for Frequent Service

Basic Service
Every 20-60 minutes most of the day, with more frequent service on some routes during peak hours

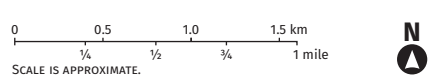
- main route
- certain trips or peak only
- infrequent section of Frequent Service route

Special Service
Hours and frequency vary by service. May only operate infrequently at certain times and not every day.

- Peak-only Bus weekday commute hours only
- Flexible service area reservations required for pick-up/drop-off anywhere in zone
- Washington State Ferry, Kitsap Fast Ferry
- Seattle Streetcar, SL, FH lines
- Seattle Center Monorail

Exceptions
Express service making limited or no stops
Suspended service

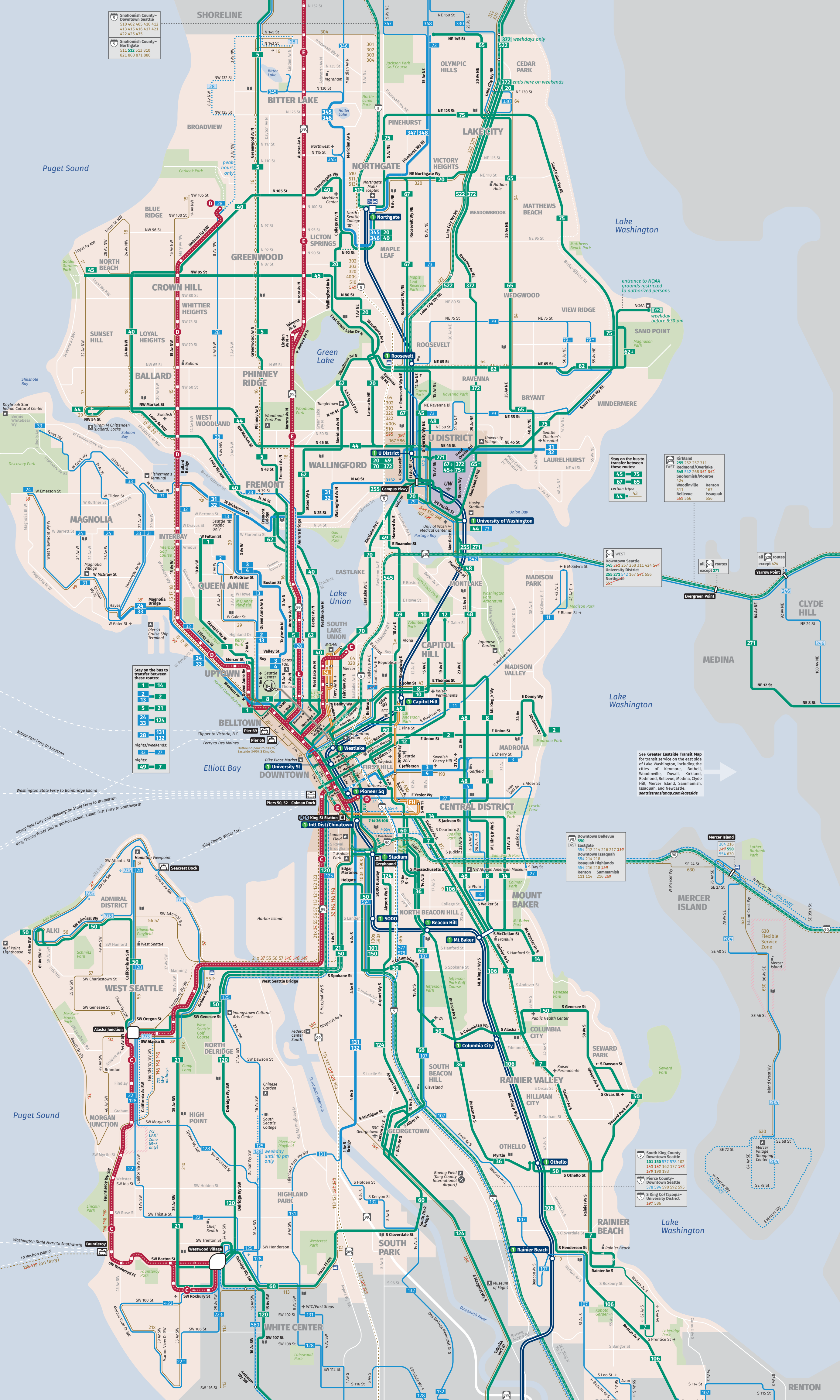
