

Seattle's Transit Network

Frequent All Day Service

Every 15 minutes or better, until 7 pm, Monday to Friday. Every 30 minutes or better until midnight every day. Most routes/lines are frequent late nights and weekends.

- Link light rail rapid transit
- Lines
- RapidRide limited stop bus for a faster ride
- Frequent bus route
- Routes combining for Frequent Service

All Day Service

Every 20-60 minutes most of the day, with more frequent service on some routes during peak hours

- main route
- certain trips or peak only
- Infrequent section of Frequent route

Special Service

Hours and frequency vary by service. May only operate infrequently at certain times and not every day.

- Peak-only Bus weekday commute bus only
- DART/Metro Flex service request pick-up/drop-off anywhere within zone
- Washington State Ferry, King County Water Taxi, Kitsap Fast Ferry
- Seattle Streetcar
- Seattle Center Monorail

Exceptions

- Express service making limited or no stops
- Suspended service
- Buses run
- Designated stop
- A lighted badge indicates a part-time service
